Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for seeking bail pending trial in case FIR No. 73 dated 02.03.2019, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 307, 379 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station P.S. North, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the injuries are simple in nature and the petitioners are in custody since 06.03.2019. Further contends that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

The above factual position regarding custody is duly acknowledged by learned counsel for U.T., Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the complainant has acknowledged the factum of compromise.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper

book.

Keeping in view the fact and circumstances discussed above and agreed stand of the parties, but without going into the legality and validity of the compromise, this Court deems it appropriate to release the petitioners from custody.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioners-Kala Singh Sandhu and Mohd. Junaid Qureshi be admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
