The petitioner is seeking regular bail in case FIR No.11 dated 15.01.2019, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 471 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that he was impersonating himself as police officer and affixed blue beacon light on his car bearing registration No.PB-06N-0027. He further contends that .32 bore revolvers which have been recovered are duly licensed in the name of the petitioner and his father and there is no allegation that he has done any after illegal activity besides merely roaming around as police officer. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 15.01.2019 and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljeet Singh

submits that challan has been presented but charges have not been framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 3 months and conclusion of the trial will take some time, I deem it to be a fit case to grant him the concession of regular bail.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
