Present petition has been filed for directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to secure the presence of respondent Nos.6 to 8 as they are involved in more than 80 criminal cases under the NDPS Act.

Pursuant to the notice, learned counsel for the State has submitted that the private-respondents have already settled the dispute in 59 complainants, whereas in around 20 cases, the presence of the accused-respondent Nos.6 to 8 has been secured and they have been produced before the Court. He submits that in the case of the petitioners, the concerned S.H.O. never received any warrants of arrest of private respondents. Learned State counsel further submits that if the petitioners bring to the notice that there is any warrants of arrest issued, the concerned S.H.O. shall take immediate action.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing for respondent Nos.6 to 8 submits that the complaint filed by the petitioners has already been

Be that as it may. If any complaint is surviving and the Court issues bailable/non-bailable warrants, the same shall be brought to the notice of the S.H.O. Concerned who has assured the Court to take action in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of.
