Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') is for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner-Sukhjinder Singh alias Ladi in case F.I.R. No.67 dated 22.12.2017 under Section 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Qadian, District Batala.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner was admitted to regular bail in this case and he had been regularly appearing before the Court. However, his bail was cancelled on account of his non appearance on date as he missed the date fixed and he is ready to surrender before learned trial Judge and furnish fresh bail bond and surety bond.

In view of the above, the present petition is accepted and in case, the petitioner surrenders before learned trial Court and moves an application for bail, learned trial Judge shall admit him on bail, subject to his furnishing fresh bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge. However, learned trial Judge shall be at liberty to complete proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C.
