The instant writ petition is directed against the order dated 08.1.2019 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Maintenance Tribunal, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali and in terms of which an application moved by respondent no.2 namely Gurnam Kaur under the provisions of Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, has been allowed and the petitioner herein has been directed to pay a monthly maintenance amount of Rs.10,000/-.

Counsel, at the very outset, seeks withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail of his statutory remedy of appeal provided under Section 16 of the 2007 Act and as has been dealt with by a Division Bench of this Court in *Paramjit Kumar Saroya Vs. The Union of India and another, 2016(3) R.C.R (Civil), 146*.

Prayer is allowed.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.

It is observed that in the eventuality of the petitioner preferring an appeal against the impugned order within a period of two weeks from today, the Appellate Authority would be obligated to entertain the same and to take a decision thereupon on merits.
