The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5, as they have married on 03.04.2019 against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners refers to the representation Annexure P-5, which was allegedly given to the Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, with a copy to SHO, Police Station Abhor, District Fazilka dated 03.04.2019 conveying the apprehension of threat and demanding the security.

As per this representation, alleged marriage was solemnized at Sanatan Dharm Mandir, Panchkula. The photographs appended in support of this petition are annexed as Annexure P-3 and the glance at the same does not reveal the place to be a temple muchless Sanatan Dharm Mandir. The alleged place of marriage appears to be a part of a residence. The

contents of the petition lack necessary particulars and do not inspire any confidence. The alleged marriage is also seriously doubtful.

In view of the above, no ground for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is made out.

Dismissed.
