Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 as they have solemnized marriage on 03.04.2019 against the wishes of private respondents.

On 05.04.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that the statements of respondent Nos.4 and 6 and father of petitioner No.1 have been recorded on 11.04.2019 and same have been filed in the Court which are taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners. In the statements it is revealed that they have no objection to the alleged marriage.

In view of the statements, there does not appear to be any existence of threat as alleged in the petition which has not given any particulars of source or mode of threat.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
