After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to approach the learned Industrial Tribunal, Bathinda (hereinafter referred to as 'the Tribunal') in the light of decision of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in 'M/s Haryana Suraj Malting Limited versus 'Phool Chand', 2018(16) SCC 567, in order to show that the petitioner was prevented by sufficient cause for its absence before the learned Tribunal when it was set aside *ex parte* and that the petitioner came to know about having been proceeded *ex parte* and the case having been decided in the absence of the petitioner only on 26.03.2019 on receipt of summons in the execution application.

In view of the position as noted above, writ petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn*** with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application before the learned Tribunal, Bathinda, in accordance with law.
