Custody certificate has been filed today in the Court. Same is taken on record.

Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.14 dated 12.02.2019 registered under Section 295 of IPC (Section 295-A IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana.

Petitioner is in custody for nearly 2 months. Challan has been presented.

All the religions teach forgiveness and tolerance. The petitioner is claimed to have shown disrespect by throwing Holy Book Sh. Guru Granth Sahib in Gurudwara. The petitioner claims that he is

mentally unstable.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody for nearly two months, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
