Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7 as they have solemnized marriage on 03.04.2019 against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the fact that the representation dated 03.04.2019 given by petitioner No.1 is absolutely similar to the representation given by a similar set of petitioners in CRM-M-15837-2019. The only difference is the particulars of the applicants given at the foot of the second page. The contents of the representation as well as the petition are vague and do not disclose convincing ground regarding alleged

source and mode of threat.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
