This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioners Paramjit Kaur, Balwinder Singh and Gurmit Kaur alias Geetu in case bearing FIR No.27 dated 07.07.2018 registered at Police Station City Zira, District Ferozepur under Sections 363-A, 366, 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 26.04.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations though inadvertently by way of typographical mistake they have been ordered to appear before the trial Court instead of the investigating officer. The same is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further

investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 26.04.2019 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
