Petitioners Trilochan Singh and Bahadur Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.28 dated 17.02.2013, registered at Police Station Panjokhra, District Ambala, under Sections 506 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per the record, the petitioners were earlier on regular bail and appearing before the trial Court. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that due to wrong noting of the date, the petitioners could not appear before the trial Court on the actual date, therefore, their bail/surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to State.

In pursuance of interim order dated 01.08.2018, passed by this

Court, the petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court and have been released on interim bail. No useful purpose would be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 01.08.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
