The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No.108 dated 24.09.2018 under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated May 10, 2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tajinder Singh Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated May 10, 2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
