The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for issuance of direction to the respondents to initiate, consider and decide the premature release case of the petitioner in the light of Punjab Government Premature Release Policy dated 08.07.1991.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the representation (Annexure P-2) is still pending before the Director General of Police, Punjab. He prays for the relief that the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Heard. The instant petition stands disposed of with direction to the respondent No.2-the Director General of Police (Prison), Punjab to look into the said representation (Annexure P-2) and decide the same as per law within a period of 90 days, after the receipt of certified copy of this order.
