Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.53 dated 12.9.2015, under Sections 323, 326, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Srari Amant Khan, District Tarn Taran.

Notice in the case was issued and in response to that status report by way of affidavit of Sucha Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tarn-Taran, District Tarn Taran has been filed. According to the status report, a cancellation report stands prepared on

28.10.2018. The relevant part of the same reads as under :-

“13. That on the basis of further investigation carried out in the present FIR No.53 dated 12.9.2015 under Sections 326, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC, P.S. Sarai Amanat Khan, Tarn Taran by SI Davinder Kumar, SHO P.S. Sarai, Amanat Khan, Tarn Taran, it has been revealed that the complainant Hardev Singh had not been caused injury by anyone rather he had sustained the injury on the wrist of his left arm due to falling on the blade of spade incidentally. No one has any fault in this regard. Therefore, again cancellation report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been prepared on 28.10.2018 in the present case by SHO P.S. Sarai Amant Khan and the cancellation report shall soon be presented before the Court of learned Illaqa Magistrate after completing procedural formalities.”

In view of the reply filed, no adjudication in this case is called for and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed off as infructuous.
