Heard.

It comes out that petitioner was granted parole on 27.2.2019 and was directed to surrender before the jail authorities on 12.4.2019. Now he has filed the present petition seeking direction to respondents to extend the parole granted to petitioner for four weeks on the grounds that his wife is suffering from Appendices. He has also moved an application dated 1.4.2019 before respondent No. 3-Jail Superintendent, Central Jail, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur for extension of parole as his wife has to undergo surgery on 10.4.2019. Therefore, his parole should be extended.

I am of the view that if the petitioner has been granted parole by the Jail Authorities, he can move to the Jail Superintendent for extension of parole and it is for the Jail Superintendent to take decision on merits. This Court cannot extend the parole granted by the jail authorities. If the petitioner is already stated to have moved to the jail authorities, the concerned Jail Superintendent is directed to decide the application, if any, filed by the petitioner within a period of two days.
