AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.36 dated 2.3.2019 registered under Sections 336, 506, 34 IPC, 1860 and Section 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Chheharta, Police Commissionerate Amritsar, District Amritsar.

On 12.4.2019, the following order was passed :-

“Today learned counsel for the petitioner states that the settlement has not yet fully been arrived at in the case cited in the last order and prays for a short adjournment to enable the parties to arrive at a compromise.

Adjourned to 23.04.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest of the petitioner

he shall be released on interim bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. However, he will join investigation as and when his presence is required.”

Today counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned DAG on instructions from ASI Harjeet Singh has accepted these factual assertions and stated that he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 12.4.2019 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
