Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Notice of motion only qua respondents No.1 to 3-State.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Amarjit Kaur Khurana, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. Copy of the paper book has been supplied.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 25.05.1991 whereas petitioner

No.2 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 06.06.1991. They have also moved a representation before the Sr. Superintendent of Police, District Police Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and certifying the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2- Sr. Superintendent of Police, District Police Batala, District Gurdaspur to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
