Inspite of two pass over, none has put in appearance on behalf of petitioner.

This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 4.10.2018 passed in CWP No. 21607 of 2018.

The operation part of the order is reproduced below:

"In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, as recorded above, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Secretary to Government of Haryana, Health Services Department, Haryana, to consider and decide the appeal dated 28.08.2017 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner under Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1987, if so maintainable, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of one week thereafter."

On 8.4.2019 learned counsel for the respondent sought time to have instructions with regard to compliance of order.

Reply with advance copy to learned counsel for the petitioner has been filed annexing the order dated 24.6.2019.

In view of order dated 24.6.2019, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

The rule issued against the respondent is hereby discharged.

However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved of order passed by respondent, he shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
