The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.224 dated 5.11.2018 at Police Station Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra under Sections 323, 324, 427, 452 and 506 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, wherein offence under Section 326 IPC was added later on.

Mr. Fariad Singh Virk, Advocate has today put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed *Vakalatnama*, which is taken on record.

The petitioner, who is stated to be armed with '*gandasi*', is attributed a 'grievous injury' on the index finger of the right hand of the

complainant although the allegations were that he had given a blow towards the head of the complainant, which the complainant managed to ward off with his hands.

The learned State counsel has informed that the petitioner has been behind bars since 31.1.2019 and that challan has already been presented.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts especially that the petitioner has been behind bars since the last more than two months and that the challan has already been presented, in my opinion, no useful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars. The petition, as such, is accepted. The petitioner Jaspal Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
