ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.84, dated 25.02.2018, under Section 20 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that 491 grams of *charas* has been recovered from him which is below the threshold of 1 kg as commercial quantity. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act and he is in custody for over 1 year since his arrest on 25.02.2018.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sher Singh, states that investigation has been completed and 4 out of 18 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, he is in custody for over a year and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
