This petition has been filed against initiation of proceedings under Section 107/150 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

On 01.01.2017, learned counsel for the petitioners had made a statement that the parties are real brothers and they have entered into a settlement and sought adjournment to move necessary petition for quashing of kalandra on the basis of compromise.

In the considered opinion of this Court, once the parties are alleged to have entered into a compromise, the petitioners are to seek quashing of kalandra on the basis of alleged settlement.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file an appropriate petition.
