Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the case of the petitioner is fully covered as per the decision rendered by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA No. 44 of 2009, decided on 15.02.2010 (Annexure P-7) for the grant of higher pay scale. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that vide order dated 30.06.2011 (Annexure P-10), though the respondents had already taken a decision to implement the said judgment, even in respect of the personnel, who were not the petitioner before this Court, but still the said benefit has not been extended to the petitioner without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 20.02.2019 (Annexure P-15) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is

issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 20.02.2019 (Annexure P-15) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
