Prayer in the present petition is to quash DDR No.19 dated 25.11.2017 under Sections 107 and 151 and Kalandra under Sections 107, 151 and 150 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

Petitioner and respondent No.2 are husband and wife. The proceedings under Section 107, 150 and 151 Cr.P.C. are normally for keeping peace. As per Section 107 Cr.P.C., the Executive Magistrate, who receives information, can require such person to show cause why he should not be ordered to execute a bond, with or without sureties for keeping the peace for such period, not exceeding one year, as the Magistrate thinks fit.

More than one year has elapsed from the date of DDR as well as from the date of Kalandra. The deed of compromise has been filed.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Respondent No.2 has already signed deed of compromise,

which has been annexed as Annexure P-3.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, Kalandra as well as consequential proceedings are directed to be closed.
