This order shall dispose of above mentioned two petitions.

These petitions have been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for

grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.163 dated 16.06.2018 registered under Sections 148/149/323/307/506 IPC and Sections 25/27/59 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has relied upon the order dated 04.04.2019 passed by this Court in ***CRM-M-11507 of 2019 titled as Tahir and others Vs. State of Haryana*** whereby the other accused were granted the concession of regular bail after having under only 9 months.

Custody certificates dated 13.05.2019 filed by way of affidavit of respective Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Gurgaon), Haryana on behalf of State have been filed and the same are taken on record. Copies supplied to counsel opposite.

As per the custody certificates the petitioners namely Ishak, Usman, Mehmood and Sahida have been in custody for 10 months and 26 days. As per the custody certificate the namely Saad has been in custody for 09 months and 23 days as on 11.04.2019 and no other case is pending against the petitioners.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Investigating Officer has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, I see no reason to take a different view for the petitioners and consequently, grant them the concession of regular bail in the same terms as in the above mentioned case.

Petitions stand allowed.

Since the main cases have been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
