Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 58 dated 25.02.2019, under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Ratia, District Fatehabad.

On 08.04.2019, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Contentends that alleged recovery of contraband is 2 Kg. of Poppy Husk and that too, from the co-accused, namely, Sona Singh.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 08.04.2019, the petitioner has joined the

investigation.

On instructions from ASI Rameshwar, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and stated that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer required in the present case.

In view of the above, the order dated 08.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
