Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No.806 dated 11.12.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 307 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

Contentends that petitioner is in custody since 31.01.2019 and he has neither been named in the FIR; nor any injury has been attributed to him. Also contends that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State Counsel, on instructions from the police official present in the Court.

Since petitioner is neither named in the FIR; nor any injury has been attributed to him; charges are yet to be considered by learned trial Court and petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case, therefore, further incarceration of the petitioner will not serve any purpose.

Consequently, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
