TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

As per pleadings on record, petitioner was allotted tender for lifting of pond ash by the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited vide work order dated 11.03.2019. The work entailed was for transporting pond ash from Lehra Mohabat to Lehra Begha/Mandi. Counsel submits that as per work order, the entire work has to be finished within a period of 5 months.

The short grievance raised in the instant writ petition is that the Tractor Trolley Union, Lehra Mohabat is deliberately hampering and hindering the lifting of the pond ash in relation to the tender that had been allotted to the petitioner. It is contended that the petitioner has his own fleet of 50 trucks and the hindrance is being done at the hands of the Tractor Trolley Union only for the reason that the tractor trolleys under the Union have not been engaged.

In the light of the short controversy raised in the petition and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the Senior Superintendent of

Police, Bathinda/respondent No.2. In the eventuality of any such representation/application being filed, respondent No.2 would be obligated to examine the same and to inquire into the matter and thereafter to take necessary remedial steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
