Reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Khubi Ram Kaushal, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Sirsa filed in Court today is taken on record. A copy of the reply is handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that in view of the replies already filed and reply filed today, the pay fixation of the petitioners have been done and the payment made. He further submits that the detailed calculations for petitioners No. 14 to 16 have been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioners and for the rest of the petitioners, the calculations details would be supplied within three weeks from today. He further argues that the directions of the Court have been complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is a difference in pay fixation done for various Districts. He seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law, if aggrieved of calculations of the amount and with regard to the fact that there is difference in calculations for various Districts.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

However, it is clarified that in case, there is a difference in pay fixation between various Districts, the petitioners may approach the respondents with a detailed representation and calculations which shall be considered expeditiously in accordance with law.
