Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to hand over the investigation of FIR No.31 dated 07.03.2019 as well as GD No.20 dated 07.03.2019, to some independent Agency like crime branch or SIT, for fair investigation and to take suitable action against respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, is directed to look into representations dated 14.03.2019 (P-4 and P-5) filed by the petitioners, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-

Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to decide representations dated 14.03.2019 (P-4 and P-5) by passing a speaking order after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
