Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against the private respondents and for registration of FIR against them, who have mercilessly beaten the petitioner, who is 60% physically handicap.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Kishan and on the basis of the affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib has stated that FIR No.60 dated 22.3.2019 under Sections 323, 451, 506 IPC against respondent No.5-Chuni Lal Bharti at Police Station City Malout has already been registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR has been registered only against one person though there are three more persons, who are cited in the complaint.

In reply, the learned counsel appearing for respondents No.4 to 7 has submitted that it is a case of cross version where a complaint has already been filed where the trial Court has passed the summoning order against the petitioner and other accused.

In view of the same, no further action is called for as the matter is sub-judice before the Illaqua Magistrate/trial Court.

Accordingly, the petition is rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the trial Court for redressal of his grievances, if any.
