Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint No.270 dated 17.11.2015 filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner was earlier admitted on bail and had been appearing regularly before the learned trial Court, but his bail was cancelled on 13.02.2019, though he had moved an application for seeking exemption from his personal appearance on medical ground. Learned counsel has placed on file a certificate (Annexure P3) indicating the fact that petitioner was under medical supervision on 13.02.2019.
