Through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 for conducting fair investigation in FIR No.89 dated 07.04.2018 registered under Sections 302 and 201 IPC at Police Station Tripri Anaj Mandi, Patiala.

Both the sides agree that if fresh investigation is conducted by the Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, they shall have no objection of any kind to its outcome. Consequently investigation is ordered to be transferred from Police Station Tripri Anaj Mandi, Patiala, to the Bureau of Investigation, Punjab. Investigating Officer, Head Constable Gurmeet Singh is directed to hand over complete file to the office of Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh, within a week from today, who shall

conclude the investigation preferably within next three months. Petitioner

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is directed to give his specimen signatures before the Bureau of Investigation. Parties shall be bound by their statement at bar that none of them shall have any objection to the investigation done by the Bureau of Investigation. If the Investigation is not concluded in the stipulated time, petitioner shall have liberty to get this petition revived.

Disposed of accordingly.
