Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to provide adequate security and protection to their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 12.

Admittedly, marriage between the petitioners was solemnized on 07.12.2014. Learned counsel contends that a child out of this wedlock was born on 14.12.2017. The petition has been filed in April 2019 seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners as they apprehend interference at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 12.

Since the marriage was solemnized in the year 2014 and previously no such apprehension was ever expressed, therefore, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
