Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to petitioner- Manjit Singh alias Mani Bhappa son of Jiwan Singh in case F.I.R. No.188 dated 13.12.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 341, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Copy of MLR of injured Jugraj Singh filed by learned counsel for the petitioner, in Court today, is taken on record.

Learned counsel representing petitioner contended that the petitioner has been attributed injury No.8 which is an abrasion only and the petitioner is in custody since 09.01.2019; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the

petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel has also affirmed the fact that the only injury attributed to the present petitioner is Injury No.8, which is an abrasion only and the petitioner is in custody since 09.01.2019.

At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage, but taking the above facts into consideration and the fact the petitioner is in custody since 09.01.2019; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner—Manjit Singh alias Mani Bhappa, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
