KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

By means of this writ petition challenge has been made to the advertisement issued for recruitment of 615 TGT Sanskrit Teachers. The petitioners are seeking exemption from HTET on the ground that they are having basic qualification of “Shastri” as well as the requisite degrees in teachers' training, and thus, the authorities should not insist for qualification of HTET examination.

According to the terms of the advertisement the last date of submission of online applications was 25.03.2019, which is come to an end. On account of delay and laches of the petitioners in approaching this Court the matter is not liable to be entertained and accordingly stands dismissed.
