Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.301 dated 28.10.2018 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 420, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 08.04.2019 :-

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that while granting anticipatory bail to the co-accused of the petitioner, the following order was passed by this Court on 01.04.2019 in CRM-M No.7584 of 2019:-

“Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, submits that though the petitioner has joined investigation,

however, recovery of the weapon i.e. sticks is yet to be effected.

List again on 03.05.2019.

Interim order to continue.

In the meantime, the petitioners are directed to appear before the SHO, Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula on 10.04.2019 at 10:00 AM and hand over the alleged sticks.

Liberty is granted to petitioners to take assistance of a lawyer at the time to appearance before the SHO.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Brij Pal, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
