TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

The instant writ petition has been filed raising a two fold grievance;

- (i) A writ of mandamus is sought directing the official respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat from respondent No.6.
- (ii) Further direction is sought against respondent Nos.3 to 5 not to sell certain mortgaged property on the premises that the petitioners herein also have interest in such property.

Counsel for the petitioners has been heard at length and the pleadings on record have been perused.

It may be noticed that the petitioners herein are two sons and wife respectively of respondent No.6, namely, Mohinder Singh. The dispute between the parties apparently seems to be a fallout of a matrimonial dispute between respondent No.3 and respondent No.6.

Insofar as prayer No.(ii) noticed herein above, it would be open for the petitioners to initiate appropriate civil proceedings if so advised in accordance with law. No intervention in such regard by this Court in exercise of the writ jurisdiction is called for.

Insofar as prayer for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners is concerned, a representation dated 15.03.2019 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is stated to have been made.

Without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to examine the representation dated 15.03.2019 (Annexure P-4) and thereafter to take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
