At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondents-Board submits that the Board has obtained a decree against M/s Hariparvat Merry Land & Resorts Ltd. in Civil Suit No.68 of 11.03.2002 from the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Ludhiana on 19.07.2012 in a suit for recovery of ₹2,32,981/- as dues of electricity charges for a temporary electric connection. During checking, the consumer was found stealing energy by taking direct supply by passing meter. The suit was decreed ex parte against the defendant.

The petitioner – M/s Deepak Builders, the subsequent occupant of the premises, was also granted a temporary connection in compliance of the interim order dated 13.02.2001 to complete the work on the allotted project within the stipulated period.

Learned counsel for the respondents-Board submits that this matter has been rendered infructuous as the project is over and nothing survives in this case.

Dismissed as such.
