Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made seeking direction to official respondents to ensure the safety and security of the petitioner, who is 73 years old and for handing over the inquiry of complaint dated 06.08.2018 (P-4) to an independent agency of some senior police officer out of District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, is directed to look into representation dated 06.08.2018 (P-4) filed by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-

Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, to decide representation dated 06.08.2018 (P-4) by passing a speaking order after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
