The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0027 dated 20.02.2019 under Sections 324, 323 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the instant FIR is the outcome of sudden quarrel between the residents of the same village. Only one injury on the little finger of Sukhwinder Singh has been caused in the incident. With the intervention of the 'panchayat', the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of compromise, which is at Annexure P3. He further contends that the petitioners have already filed CRM-M No.14164 of 2019 for quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise and the statements of the parties are to be recorded before the trial Court on 06.05.2019.

This Court, by the order dated 09.04.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the

satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 09.04.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
