The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.575 dated 09.10.2018 registered under Sections 148, 307, 323, 325, 506, 120-B 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted and created in collusion of the Police officers just as a counter blast to the FIR which was lodged against the complainant of the present case and his co-accused, on account of murder of the wife of the petitioner. Otherwise, there is not even allegation that any injury was caused to anybody from the side of the complainant in this incident. It is also submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 02.03.2019. There is no other case against the petitioner. Investigation of the case is completed and challan has already been filed.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel submits that there is allegation against the petitioner qua making an attempt on the life of the complainant. Therefore, the petitioner does not deserve any concession of

bail. However, it is not disputed that no person from the side of the complainant has received any injury in the incident. It is also not disputed that there is no other case against the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without commenting any further upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
