Petitioner-Kamlesh Rani has filed this petition for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to transfer the investigation of FIR No.199 dated 30.10.2018 registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga to respondent No.4, on the ground that her husband was falsely implicated in the case.

On 24.07.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned State counsel is directed to find out the status of the investigation in case FIR No.199 dated 30.10.2018 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply three sets of the paper book.

Adjourned to 19.08.2019.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh has apprised the Court that the investigation of the case is complete and the challan against the accused is likely to be filed within next two weeks.

Learned counsel has placed reliance upon CCTV footage to prove innocence of accused. The argument of the learned counsel that the husband of the petitioner has been falsely implicated is misconceived at this stage.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for interference.

However, it shall be open for the accused to raise all the issues raised in this petition before the trial Court at an appropriate stage.

Petition is dismissed.
