The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.181, dated 11.06.2018, registered under Sections 307, 323, 326, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala (P-1) on the basis of compromise (P-2).

FIR in this case was got registered by respondent No.2- Ramandeep Kaur who is wife of petitioner No.1-Satpinder Singh against the latter and her other members of in-laws family due to matrimonial discord between the parties. Pursuant to order dated 06.08.2018, the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, has submitted his report dated 04.09.2018, wherein on the basis of the statements of the parties, it has been submitted that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine, voluntarily, without any threat and coercion. Since, the parties have amicably settled their grievance against each other and petitioner No.1 and respondent No.2 have now decided to get their marriage dissolved under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and to live their life with peace and tranquility, it would be in the interest of the parties, if the petition is allowed.

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In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.181, dated 11.06.2018, registered under Sections 307, 323, 326, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala (P-1) along with all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioners.
