Present petition has been filed praying for protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners, in view of the marriage solemnized by them against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 10.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and three copies of the petition have been supplied to him in the Court.

4. The documents annexed by the petitioners including the Aadhar Cards and Marriage Certificate show that both are major and are

present in Court also duly identified by their counsel. They apprehend danger to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10. Therefore, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, as per law.

5. However, it is made clear that this order may not be construed as expression of an opinion on legality and validity of the marriage of the petitioners.

6. With the above direction, the petition stands disposed off.

7. In case any criminal case is pending against petitioner No.1, this order shall not be any hindrance to proceed according to law.
