This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.16 dated 09.01.2019 registered under Sections 353, 186, 279, 336, 307, 120-B IPC, Sections 25/54 of the Arms Act, Section 5/13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 and Sections 11,59,60 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition and states that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail before the court below and a direction be issued to the court to decide his bail application expeditiously. I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the court on or before 17.05.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided in accordance with law expeditiously but in any case by 20.05.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
