Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.19 dated 14.02.2016, under Sections 336, 506, 148, 149, 427 IPC and Section 25,27,54,59 of Arms act, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon District Ludhiana on the basis of investigation report dated 20.12.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that although the petitioners had filed this petition for quashing of FIR, however, the police have filed reply to the petition stating therein; that they have filed the report of 'untraceable' before the Magistrate. It is further submitted by the counsel that the petitioners are satisfied with the police report, therefore, the present petition be dismissed as infructuous, in terms of the report filed by the police before the Magistrate.

In view of the above, petition stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
