Learned counsel for the respondents states that the delay has occurred in deciding the representation as it involves shifting of the electric poles of 11 KV which involves long procedure. Moreover, the petitioner is challenging the already shifted pole. On instructions from Mr. Santokh Singh, Senior Executive Officer, PSPCL, he further submits that the representation of the petitioner would be decided within four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the statement made today in Court, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against the order passed.
