Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as counsel for
the complainant along with the complainant, who is present in person
and Mr. Manish Jain, Addl.P.P., for the respondent-U.T. Chandigarh,
submit that the parties have effected a settlement dated 16.07.2019
which is placed on the report of the Mediator on the file of this case.

The complainant further stated that she does not objects
if the present petition is allowed.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Sarwan Ram, Police Station CAW, Chandigarh, has sympathetically stated that the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation and has no objection if the same is allowed as nothing remains to be recovered.

In light of the stand of the two sides and the fact that the settlement has been brought about in this matrimonial dispute, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner-Vineet Kumar is ordered to be released on bail on his appearance before the Investigating Officer subject to fulfilling all the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
