Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
for setting aside of the impugned order dated 13.12.2011 (P-1) as
well as the order dated 20.08.2010 (P-2) passed by learned Additional
Sessions Judge, Ferozepur and Judicial Magistrate First Class, Abohar
(for short 'JMIC') respectively.

It transpires that the petitioner has filed a complaint under
Section 420, 467 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, but the same
was dismissed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Abohar.
Also necessary to mention here that on the same set of allegations FIR
No. 154 dated 15.07.2003 under Sections 420, 467 and 120-B of the
Indian Penal Code was also registered and after investigation the
cancellation report was submitted and which was also accepted by
learned JMIC while passing the impugned order dated 20.08.2010.

Aggrieved against the above said order, the petitioner had filed a revision petition before the learned Sessions Court, but the same was dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozpur.

Since the matter pertains to the year 2012. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Dismissed for non prosecution.
